Reminder emails (with the survey link) will follow mid-September and end of month.

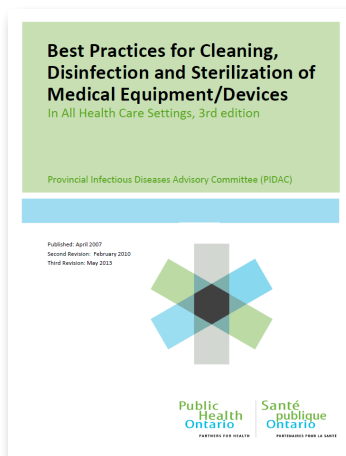
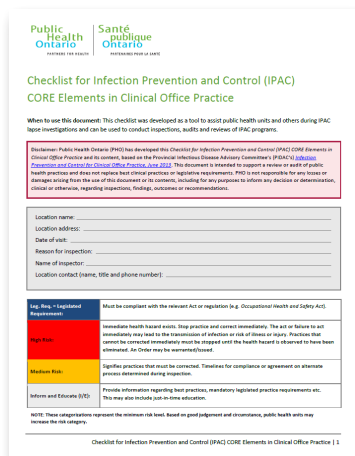
